



Good Evening Imagine Madison Families,

Due to the Ohio Stay At Home Order still being in effect, we will be using *Distance Learning* in order to ensure that our scholars can continue to receive their education. The majority of the lessons will be taking place online with the zoom app with weekly lesson plan extensions and assignments designed to accompany the distance learning that we will be mailing to every Imagine Madison student next week. As a result of this shift in instruction, we will need the following from each of you:

1. Ensure that you create a zoom account and have your scholar check in with their teacher for their pre/post assessments **every Friday based on the time that the teacher gives you to check into the zoom app. You will find assessment times for your scholar within their instructional packets that will be mailed the week of April 6th.** You will find this information in the instructional packet that will be mailed out to you the week of April 6th 2020. If you have any questions please contact your scholar's teacher.
2. Our teachers have been working hard to contact you to determine if you are in need of assistance regarding free internet from Buckeye Broadband or if your scholar is in need of a device with web cam capabilities which will be needed to complete the distance learning assignments from our teachers. Due to the circumstances, It is **mandatory** for your scholar to participate in our virtual learning sessions to determine grade level mastery. We will consider their participation rates in our final determinations regarding passage to the next grade level.
3. Ensure that your students are watching the prerecorded lessons from their teacher prior to the Friday post assessments every week. Two Reading and two math prerecorded lessons will be available every week for your child's class to prepare them for the Friday assessments on-line via zoom.com. Please look for information in your scholar's instructional packet that will be mailed to you the week of April 6th regarding assessment schedule time.

5. Reach out to your child's teacher during their scheduled office hours of 10:00-1:00 Monday-Thursday starting the week of April 6th if you have any questions, concerns, or feedback.
6. Spring Break will take place **April 10th – April 20th. School will resume Monday, April 20th. During this time, distance learning will not be in session.**
7. To keep our spirits high, actively participate in our Digital Spirit Week the week of April 6th.
8. Reach out to us. We know this is a confusing time and we are here to help in any way that we can.

Distance Learning classrooms will begin officially on Monday, April 6th, 2020. We will re-evaluate on Friday, May 1st, 2020 based on the direction of the Governor and the Ohio Department of Education. **Please reach out to the main office (419-259-4000) if you are in need of internet access or a device for your scholar(s) to complete the distance learning assignments from your scholar's teacher.**
