In response to yesterday's event, I would like to take a moment to reassure you that the safety of our students and staff is our highest priority. Our campus is reviewing and, where appropriate, will strengthen our school safety and security measures. If you have any questions about school security policies and procedures, please do not hesitate to contact me.

Given the extensive media coverage of this latest tragedy, we know families and faculty want to do everything possible to help children regain a sense of security and normalcy in their daily routines at school. Experts encourage us to use sensitivity and age-appropriate context in answering questions and concerns truthfully. We also encourage students to express their emotions, affirming all expressions rather than dismissing or discouraging certain feelings. Children should be affirmed that they are loved and that their responses are normal. Experts encourage all of us to be mindful of signs that a child may need additional support such as aggressiveness, withdrawal, etc.
